Instructional Strategies

Slide 3	<p>Vocabulary: Introduction</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read and repeat new words <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What silly things can you do? Wiggle your nose? Wiggle your ears? Cross your eyes?
Slide 4	<p>Vocabulary: Read & comprehend</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Draw a line from the feature to the word What other parts do you know? Can you label them?
Slide 5	<p>Vocabulary: Categorize</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write the words in the correct column
Slide 7	<p>Phonics: Introduce "D & T" sound</p> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has anyone seen these letters? What sound do they make? Brainstorm 5 words that start with these letters / end with these letters
Slide 8	<p>Phonics: Practice "D & T" sound</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read and repeat words in the box Match them to the pictures <p>Advanced Discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can anyone identify any rhyming words in this list?
Slide 10-12	<p>Phonics: Let's play a game!</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tell students to take out their worksheets Show the students Slide 12 for 10 seconds – don't let them write anything on their paper Quickly open a blank whiteboard and tell the students to write down the words they remember Write the words on the whiteboard as a class – Did everyone remember all the words? Repeat for Slide 15 and Slide 16 – they get more challenging
Slide 13 - 25	<p>Reading a story: Things I Like</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Answer the pre-reading questions together as a class Work as a class to read the story together Answer the questions at the end as a class
Slide 26 - 27	<p>Using Visual Cues: Introduction</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Act out/draw some of Makaio's favourite things and try to guess what they are Act out/draw some of your favourite things and try to guess what they are

Slide 28	<p>Present Tense: Introduction</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write a sentence in present tense. How do you know it's present tense? What does it mean? • Ask everyone to write one sentence in present tense and one sentence in negative present tense on the slide • Check everyone's answers and ensure proper subject-verb agreement
Slide 29	<p>Present Tense: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the sentences • Identify the present tense • Prompt students to identify the patterns in verb formation
Slide 30	<p>Present Tense: Practice</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask students to complete the sentences
Slide 31 -32	<p>Review: Face Vocabulary</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play Simon Says using facial features as prompts "Simon says point to your nose" "Simon says wiggle your eyebrows"
Slide 33	<p>Review: Sounds "D & T"</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask students to Ask students to write down as many words they can remember on the slide
Slide 34	<p>Review: Using Visual Cues</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make different expressions at the students • Ask them to guess what you're feeling based on your expressions • Take turns
Slide 35	<p>Review: Present Tense</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give students funny prompts to begin sentences: "Godzilla doesn't like _____" "Harry Potter always _____" etc.
Slide 36	<p>Homework: Writing</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell students they will write a few sentences using present tense • Review the examples • Emphasize the subject-verb agreement
