Instructional Strategies

Slide 3	<p>Vocabulary: Introduction - Adjectives</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review adjectives <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Everyone write down 5 adjectives that describe themselves
Slide 4	<p>Vocabulary: Read & recognize</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read the paragraph together Circle the adjectives
Slide 6	<p>Vocabulary: Generate</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the letters of the word "Superheroes" to find as many small words as possible Example: see, pour, she, he etc.
Slide 8	<p>Phonics: Introduce "m" and "n" sound</p> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What sound do they make? Can anyone think of words with "m" or "n" in them? Write the words on the slide. BONUS: Can you think of a word with both those letters in them?
Slide 9	<p>Phonics: Practice "m" and "n" sound</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read and repeat words in the box Match them to the pictures
Slide 10	<p>Phonics: Unscramble</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prompt students to unscramble the letters to write "m" and "n" words Match the words to the picture
Slide 12	<p>Phonics: Hangman</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask students to choose words with "m" and "n" in them to use for a game of hangman
Slide 13	<p>How much & How many: Introduction</p> <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When do we see these words together? What do they mean? What kind of answer are we looking for? <p>Write the responses on the slide</p>
Slide 14	<p>How much & How many: Review</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review the rules and guidelines Generate examples of count and non-count nouns
Slide 15	<p>How much & How many: Practice</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fill in the blanks with "much" or "many"
Slide 16	<p>How much & How many: Apply</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fill in the blanks and complete the dialogue Take turns speaking the dialogue

Slide 18 Story 19-24	<p>Re-telling a Story: Introduction</p> <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Let's look at the cover of this book • What do you think it's about? How do you know? • Explain that you will be reading a story and the students will write it down afterward. What kind of strategies should they be using?
Slide 25	<p>Re-telling a Story: Practice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work together to generate keywords from the story • Discuss the plot of the story together • Ask students to write the story on paper • Read the stories together to the class
Slide 26 - 27	<p>Vocabulary: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask students if they remember the first and second superheroes they saw today • Describe the pictures • Write down the adjectives as students generate them • Emphasize how adjectives paint a picture in our brain
Slide 28	<p>Phonics: Review – “m” and “n”</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brainstorm as many words as possible that contain “m” and “n” • Write them on the slide
Slide 29	<p>How much & How many: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask students about the things in their room. • Example: How many pencils do you have? How much water did you drink today?
Slide 30	<p>Retelling a story: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brainstorm different times students tell stories • Example: when they get home from school, in their journal etc.
Slide 31	<p>Homework: Writing</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell students they will re-tell a story about their childhood.
