

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



# How much vs How many

How much	How many
Use with countable nouns	<ul> <li>Use with uncountable nouns</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Things you can pick up and count</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Things that you can NOT count</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Usually ends with an -s</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Doesn't usually end with an -s</li> </ul>
Example: apples, pictures, pencils, dog	Example: water, rice
