	 Read and repeat new words 	
	 Act out the animals 	
	Discuss:	
	 Does anyone have a pet? What kind? Why not? 	
	What sound does a make?	
Slide 2	Vocabulary: Read & comprehend	
	Strategy:	
	 Draw a line from the animal to the word 	
	 Circle an animal and ask students to make the sound/say its name 	
Slide 3	Vocabulary: Spell & recognize	
	Strategy:	
	Play hangman	
	Give assistance if necessary – vowels, first letter etc.

	How is a pet different from a wild animal? Strate and

Slide 11	Phonics: Recognize "CK" sound

	 Work together to find the words in the puzzle 	
	 Cross off the words and the pictures as students work through the puzzle 	
Slide 12	Writing a story: Introduction

	• Explain to the students that they will write a story as a class.

	 Look at the picture of these dogs and develop a backstory 	
	Discuss:	
	What are these dogs' names?	
	What do they like to do? Are they friends?	
	 Are they friends? 	

	Write the details on a whiteboard slide
Slide 14	Writing a story: Developing plot
	 Watch the video a few times and discuss what happens
Slide 15	Writing a story: Putting it all together
	 Prompt the students to say sentences describing the dogs
	 Ask the students to describe what happens
	Write it down on a whiteboard
	Readit together

	Milktea is a dog like a cow. She likes to play very much! She always goes out in the
	morning and comes back at night.
	Rainbow had a cookie. Milktea took the cookie. He ate the cookie. Rainbow found his master and got another cookie.
Slide 16	Writing a story: Creativity and Prediction
	 Ask the students to write their own 3 sentence ending to the story on their
	worksheets
	 Set a time limit for five minutes
	 Draw a picture as other students catch up
	Discuss:
	What happens next? Are the deer still friends?
	 Are the dogs still friends? Who will get the next cookie? Etc.
Slide 17	Adjectives: Introduction
	Discuss:
	 What is an adjective?
	Why do we use adjectives?
	Strategy:
	 Brainstorm adjectives to describe the lizard on the slide Write the words on the slide
Slide 18	Adjectives: Controlled Practice
	Discuss:
	 Identify different categories of adjectives
	Strategy:
Slide 20	Work together to complete the table describing the animal on the screen Adjectives: Free Practice
	Strategy
	 Give students one minute to find a toy or object they want to share with
	the class
	 Ask them to write adjectives that describe it on their worksheet
	Share the item and adjectives with the class
	Note!
	 Make sure to prepare a model using your own item and adjectives for the students
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Slide 22	Vocabulary: Review
	Strategy:
	 Remind students that they learned 9 new pet words today
	 Work together to brainstorm all 9 animals
	 Write the animals on the screen
Slide 23	Phonics: Review
	Strategy:
	 Ask students what sound they learned today
	 Brainstorm at least 5 words that have that sound
Slide 24	Writing a story: Review
	Strategy:
	 Congratulate students for writing a story
	 Tell them to share it with their parents
	Option here: Email the entire story (including what was written on the
	whiteboard/slides) so they have the entire story to refer to
Slide 25	Adjectives: Review
	Strategy:
	 Brainstorm adjectives to describe the turtle
Slide 26	Homework: Writing
	Strategy:
	 Tell students they will write a few sentences about their favourite pet
	Review the example
	 Emphasize the use of adjectives
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
