## Instructional Strategies

Slide 1	<p>Vocabulary: Introduction</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read and repeat new words</li> <li>• Act out the animals</li> </ul> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does anyone have a pet? What kind? Why not?</li> <li>• What sound does a _____ make?</li> </ul>
Slide 2	<p>Vocabulary: Read &amp; comprehend</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a line from the animal to the word</li> <li>• Circle an animal and ask students to make the sound/say its name</li> </ul>
Slide 3	<p>Vocabulary: Spell &amp; recognize</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Play hangman</li> <li>• Give assistance if necessary – vowels, first letter etc.</li> </ul>
Slide 7	<p>Vocabulary: Categorize</p> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How is a pet different from a wild animal?</li> </ul> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw a line from the animal to its corresponding category</li> </ul> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What animal on this slide would you most like for a pet? Why?</li> </ul>
Slide 9	<p>Phonics: Introduce "CK" sound</p> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has anyone seen these letters together?</li> <li>• What sound do they make?</li> <li>• Can anyone think of words with "CK" in them? Write the words on the slide</li> </ul>
Slide 10	<p>Phonics: Practice "CK" sound</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read and repeat words in the box</li> <li>• Match them to the pictures</li> </ul> <p>Advanced Discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can anyone identify any rhyming words in this list?</li> </ul>
Slide 11	<p>Phonics: Recognize "CK" sound</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work together to find the words in the puzzle</li> <li>• Cross off the words and the pictures as students work through the puzzle</li> </ul>
Slide 12	<p>Writing a story: Introduction</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explain to the students that they will write a story as a class.</li> </ul>
Slide 13	<p>Writing a story: Characters</p> <p>Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Look at the picture of these dogs and develop a backstory</li> </ul> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are these dogs' names?</li> <li>• What do they like to do?</li> <li>• Are they friends?</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write the details on a whiteboard slide</li> </ul>
Slide 14	<p>Writing a story: Developing plot Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Watch the video a few times and discuss what happens</li> </ul>
Slide 15	<p>Writing a story: Putting it all together Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prompt the students to say sentences describing the dogs</li> <li>Ask the students to describe what happens</li> <li>Write it down on a whiteboard</li> <li>Read it together</li> </ul> <p>Real Student Example:  Milktea is a dog like a cow. She likes to play very much! She always goes out in the morning and comes back at night.  Rainbow had a cookie. Milktea took the cookie. He ate the cookie. Rainbow found his master and got another cookie.</p>
Slide 16	<p>Writing a story: Creativity and Prediction Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask the students to write their own 3 sentence ending to the story on their worksheets</li> <li>Set a time limit for five minutes</li> <li>Draw a picture as other students catch up</li> </ul> <p>Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What happens next?</li> <li>Are the dogs still friends?</li> <li>Who will get the next cookie? Etc.</li> </ul>
Slide 17	<p>Adjectives: Introduction Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What is an adjective?</li> <li>Why do we use adjectives?</li> </ul> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Brainstorm adjectives to describe the lizard on the slide</li> <li>Write the words on the slide</li> </ul>
Slide 18	<p>Adjectives: Controlled Practice Discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identify different categories of adjectives</li> </ul> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Work together to complete the table describing the animal on the screen</li> </ul>
Slide 20	<p>Adjectives: Free Practice Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Give students one minute to find a toy or object they want to share with the class</li> <li>Ask them to write adjectives that describe it on their worksheet</li> <li>Share the item and adjectives with the class</li> </ul> <p>Note!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make sure to prepare a model using your own item and adjectives for the students</li> </ul>

Slide 22	<p>Vocabulary: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remind students that they learned 9 new pet words today</li> <li>• Work together to brainstorm all 9 animals</li> <li>• Write the animals on the screen</li> </ul>
Slide 23	<p>Phonics: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask students what sound they learned today</li> <li>• Brainstorm at least 5 words that have that sound</li> </ul>
Slide 24	<p>Writing a story: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Congratulate students for writing a story</li> <li>• Tell them to share it with their parents</li> </ul> <p>Option here: Email the entire story (including what was written on the whiteboard/slides) so they have the entire story to refer to</p>
Slide 25	<p>Adjectives: Review</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Brainstorm adjectives to describe the turtle</li> </ul>
Slide 26	<p>Homework: Writing</p> <p>Strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tell students they will write a few sentences about their favourite pet</li> <li>• Review the example</li> <li>• Emphasize the use of adjectives</li> </ul>
