Slide 4- 5	Describing a picture: Warmup Strategy (use worksheet):
Slide 6- 8	Describing a picture: Apply Work together to describe these pictures Begin with verbal descriptions together to having students write independently.
Slide 9- 10	There is / There are: Introduction Strategy: Read the sentences Emphasize the use of singular and plural (is vs are) Emphasize the quantifiers (number, some, a/an etc.)
Slide 11	There is / There are: Activate Strategy: • Look at the pictures and connect the words to make accurate sentences
Slide 12	There is / There are: Apply Strategy Look at the picture and fill in the blanks with the correct verb and quantifier
Slide 14 - 15	Simple Sentences: Apply Strategy Play the game as described on Slide 14 Ask students to choose a letter to write their sentences Emphasize subject verb agreement and word order To add additional challenge: request specific tenses, offer specific vocabulary, choose more challenging letters
