Slide 19	Prediction: Introduction Strategy:  • What is prediction? Why is it good to guess things?
Slide 20	Prediction: Pre-Reading Discuss:  • Ask the questions on the slides
Slide 21-23	Film: Play and predict Strategy:  • Play the first 2:40 of the movie. PRESS PAUSE.
Slide 24	Prediction: Confirm Strategy:  • Watch the ending to the film.  • Answer the questions as a class
Slide 26	Vocabulary: Review Strategy:  • Prompt students with the names of animals • Write their sounds on the slide
Slide 27	Phonics: Review-SH Strategy:  • Draw some dashes on the slide to play hangman with one of the "SH" words from the lesson
Slide 28	Alphabetical Order: Review Strategy:  • Check the worksheet to make sure the students got the words in the correct order
Slide 29	Making predictions: Review Strategy: • Remind students why prediction is so important
Slide 26	Homework: Writing Strategy:  • Tell students they will write a few sentences using prediction  • Review the film  • Brainstorm potential next day events
