Slide	Phonics: Review-Tongue Twisters	
3-5	Discuss:	
	Before the tongue twister, ask: What sound does make?      What words do you know with sound?	
	<ul> <li>What words do you know with sound?</li> <li>Strategy:</li> </ul>	
	Say tongue twisters	
	How many times can you say it in 30 seconds?	
	Who can say it fastest?	
	Why are tongue twisters so difficult?	
Slide 6	Adjectives: Review	
	Discuss and write on the slide:	
	<ul><li>What is an adjective?</li><li>What are some examples of adjectives?</li></ul>	
Slide 7	Adjectives: Generate	
	Strategy:	
	Find something in your house to share with your classmates	
	<ul> <li>Use your worksheet to describe it with adjectives</li> </ul>	
	Share your answers with the class	
Slide 8	Adjectives: Challenge	
	Strategy:	
	<ul> <li>Use the worksheet to see the alphabet</li> <li>Challenge students to write one adjective for every letter of the alphabet</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Set a timer based on the strength of your class</li> </ul>	
Slide 9	Adjectives: Apply	
	Strategy	
	<ul> <li>Ask students to write 5 adjectives describing themselves</li> </ul>	
	Share their words with the class	
Slide 10	Ordinals: Review Discuss and write on whiteboard:	
	What are ordinals?	
	What die Ordinals     When do we use ordinals	
Slide 11	Ordinals: Review and match	
	Strategy	
	<ul> <li>Ask students to draw lines between ordinals, numbers and words</li> </ul>	
Slide	Ordinals: Apply	
12 – 13	Explain to students you will ask them questions like "Who is the oldest?"  Advantage of the students you will be a student will be a	
	Ask students to guess what the order will be – "Teacher will be first, I will be seemed. Many will be third" etc.

	See if the guesses were correct

	Ask students to connect the letters in the correct alphabetical order	
	<ul> <li>Challenge: Time students – who can go the fastest?</li> </ul>

	Brainstorm the names of all the animals	
	Write the names on the slide	
	<ul> <li>Use the worksheet to put them in alphabetical order</li> </ul>	
	Share your answers	
Slide	Writing a story:	
17-20	Strategy	
	Look at the picture	
	<ul> <li>Answer the questions in the purple box</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Take turns adding sentences or ideas to the story</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Draw a picture on the worksheet</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Use prediction – what will happen next?</li> </ul>
