	Strategy	
	 Connect the numbers to make a picture 	
Slide 15	Numerical order: Warmup	
Side 15	Numerical order: Warmup Strategy	
	 Play game: Fizz, buzz, beep 	
	 Go around the class counting – if your number has a 2, 5, or 8 in it – 	
	say the corresponding word. If you accidentally say the number,	
	you're out!	
	 Example: 1, fizz, 3, 4, buzz, 6, 7, beep, 9, 10, 11, fizz, 13, 14, buzz etc.

	 Ask students to write their answers on their worksheet first
	 Share the answers together by writing them on the slides

	Discuss
	What is order by date?
	 Why is it important?
	 When can we use it?
	Write the answers on the slide

	 Using birthdates of students in the class – order by date: month, year, date

	Order by date: ApplyStrategy:
19-23	 Work together to identify the order of the dates
	 Identify different categories (months, days of the week, year etc.)
Slide	Following Directions: Introduction
24-25	Strategy:
	 Explain to the students that they will draw a picture as a class using only
	verbaldirections
	 Identify some of the necessary vocabulary
	 Order words: First, second, third
	 Direction words: Top, bottom, middle, across
	 Shape words: Circle, square, oval, rectangle
Slide 26	Following Directions: Application
	Strategy:
	 Using a thick marker, draw a picture on a piece of white paper
	 Narrate the process to the students (but don't show them your drawing)
	 After the picture is complete – hold it up to the camera
	 Do they look the same?
	 Give the students a chance to be the narrator
	If possible: draw pictures of pets – a fish in a bowl, a dog with a bone etc.
Slide 26	Vocabulary: Review
	Strategy:
	 Ask students if they remember the first and second pictures they saw today
	 Describe the pictures
	 Write down the adjectives as students generate them
	 Emphasize how adjectives paint a picture in our brain
Slide 27	Phonics: Review - FL
	Strategy:
	 Brainstorm as many words as possible that contain "FL"
	Write them on the slide
Slide 28	Numerical Order: Review
	Strategy:
	 Play another game of fizz, buzz, pop – allow each student in the class to
	choose the numbers matched with fizz, buzz, pop
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Slide 29	 Following instructions: Review Strategy: Brainstorm different times students give and follow directions Example: recipes, playing games, getting ready for school, cleaning their room etc.
