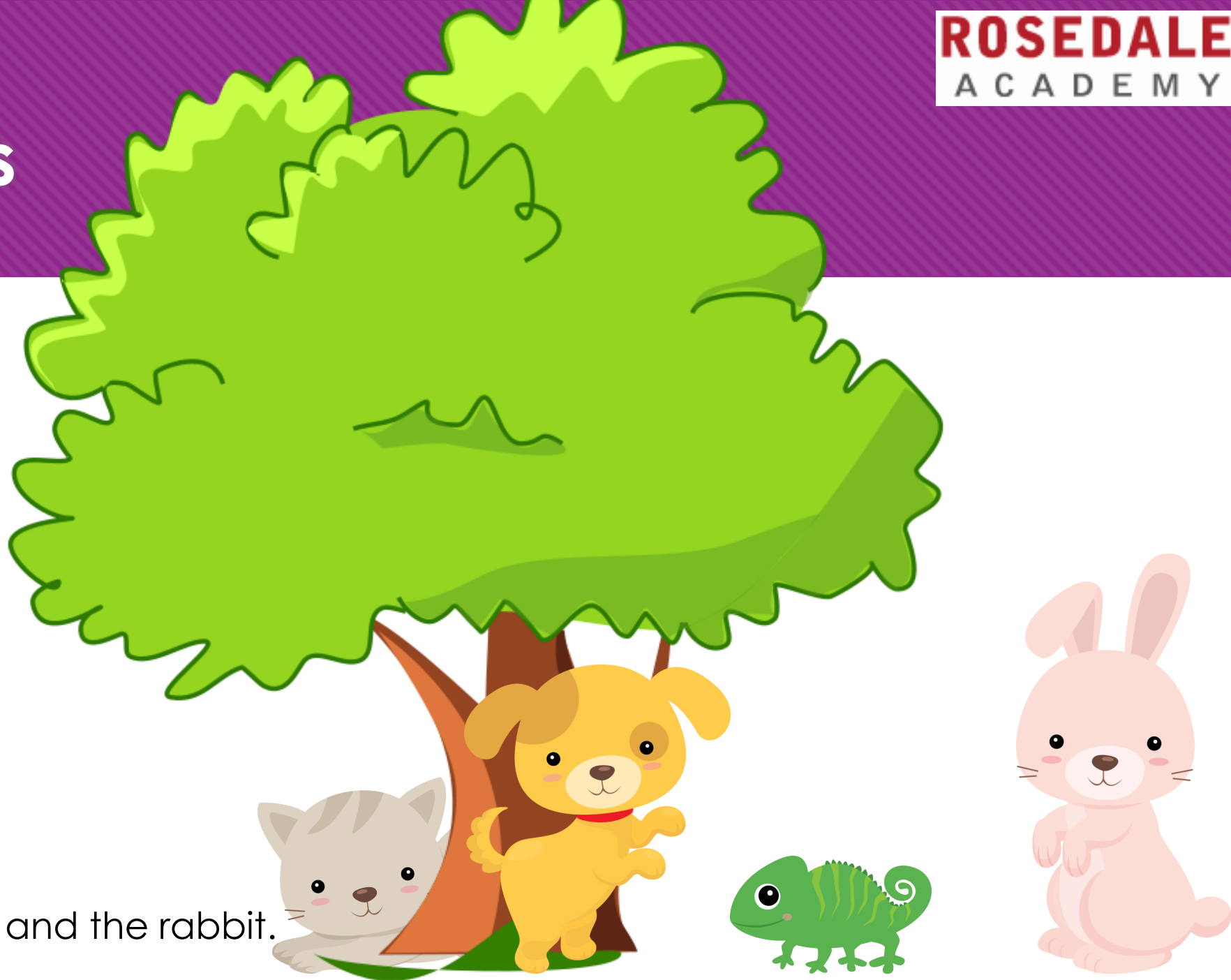
The dog is in front of the tree.

The cat is behind the tree.

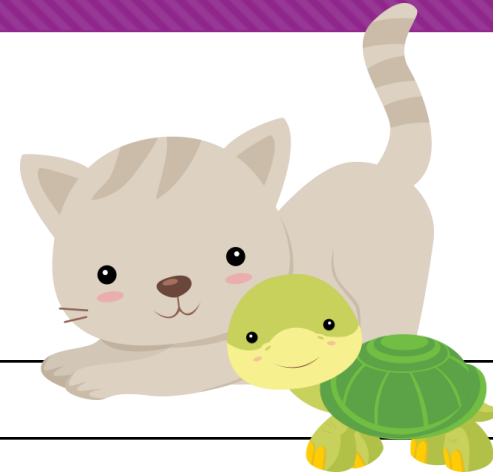
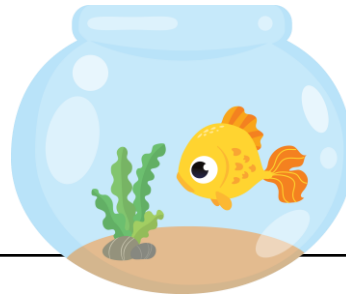
The lizard is beside the tree.
