	Scroll back to article if students need prompting

	Ask students to draw a picture of the story	
	Share the pictures	
	Describe why they drew what they did

	Discussion:	
	Discuss answers to the questions on the slides	
	Prompt students to explain why

01. 1 0.5	Ask each student to brainstorm 3 words that have TH in them

	<ul> <li>Ask students to describe 3 things they do every morning using the word "Always"</li> </ul>	
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Slide 36	Review: Telling key events from a news story
