Super Duper Flea jumped from Mrs Meany onto her cat. The cat scratched and scratched.


The postman arrived. Super Duper Flea jumped from the cat onto the postman.

The boy scratched and scratched. He was late for school. The teacher frowned at him. "Late again," she said.


Super Duper Flea jumped from the boy onto the teacher.

Super Duper Flea saw twenty children in the classroom. He jumped from the teacher onto the children. The children scratched and scratched.


Super Duper Flea grew fatter and fatter. He was so fat, the children could see him jumping out of the classroom door.

The children and teachers all went home.


Super Duper Flea went to see what else he could find. He jumped onto a horse and then he jumped onto a cow. At milking time, he jumped onto the farmer.




The farmer scratched and scratched.




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Homework
