






### This and That Pronouns

When do we use the words "this" and "that"?



Close to us.

Far away from us.





Use "this" if the item is <u>close</u> to you. Use "that" if the item is <u>far away</u> from you.

"This is my computer chair"


"That is my bookshelf"

"This is my pencil"

"That is my mother"
