



#### A Fast Sport

Hockey is an **exciting** sport. Hockey players skate very fast on the ice.



A puck is a small, flat circle made of hard rubber.

#### Some Game Rules

Hockey players play on a team. A hockey team has six players. The team works together to try to win the game.



The game starts in the middle of the ice.

A round, black puck is dropped between one player from each team.


The two players try to get control of the puck.



Hockey • Level I



Players move the puck on the ice with a long stick. They try to hit the puck into a net to **score** points. The team with more points at the end of the game wins.





Players shoot the puck into the other team's net.

Players try to keep the puck with their team.

They try to take the puck from the other team and score a **goal**.

They also try to stop the other team from making a goal.

Hockey • Level I





Gloves and leg pads help the goalie stop speeding pucks.

One player on each team stays by the net.
This player tries to stop pucks from going into the net.
Pucks can move faster than cars on a highway!



A coach can help you learn to play hockey.


