The watch with jewelry was stolen. Mike deem that was stolen by Todd without any definite evidence but Mike still want to expel Todd. Susan thinks that is not fair to Todd because there's no evidence. Todd make a lie on his application and sworn bonding form. On that day, only Todd touched the watch and he didn't pass the test which is testing if you steal the watch.

There is no exactly evidence to support that Todd is thief. Todd behaves affectedly on his file. Also, Mike arbitrarily believes that Todd is the thief without evidence.

If Susan can't make this theft case clearly, she shouldn't expel Todd because it's not ethical to him. Also, the company's image will be dama ^{1.2} if Susan expel Todd without any thinking. So, this action may decrease customer source to lost profits. At the same time, Mike is too enthusiastic to expel Todd, their relationship may be unharmonious so if Todd is expelled, this situation is good to Mike. Moreover, Susan and Mike are all facing a serious problem: they didn't do the best on their job so they probably be punished.
