We can Go Green if we **Reduce, Reuse and Recycle!**

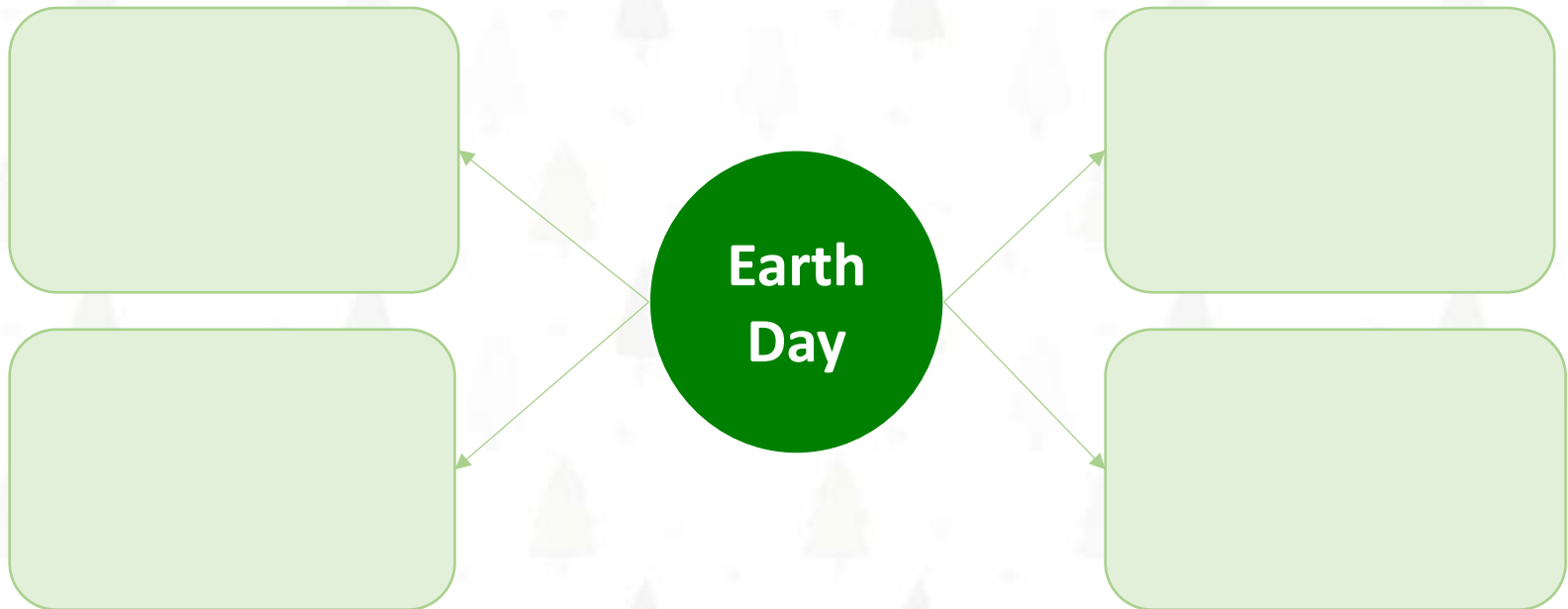

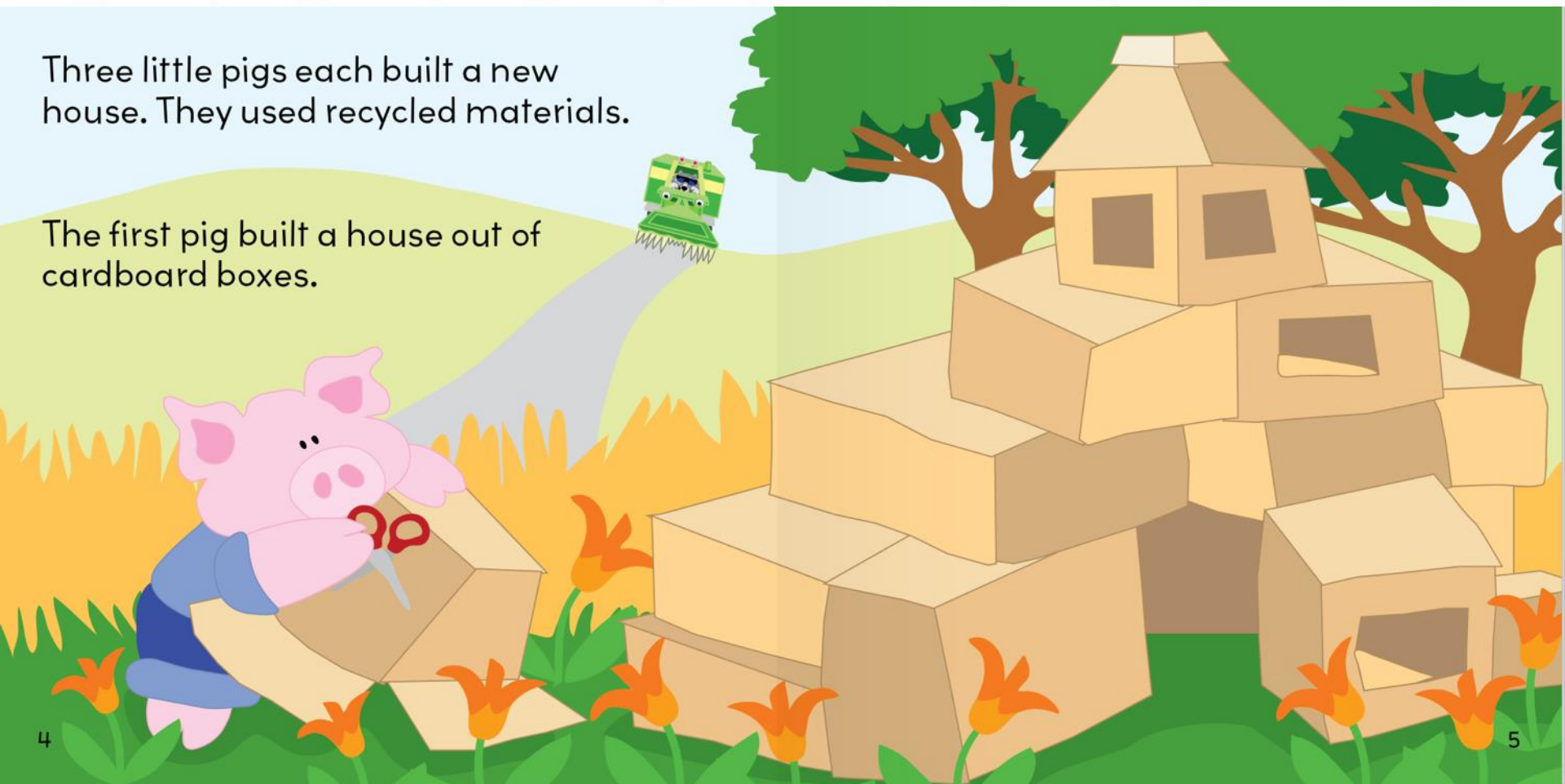


The Three Little Recyclers

and glued them together.



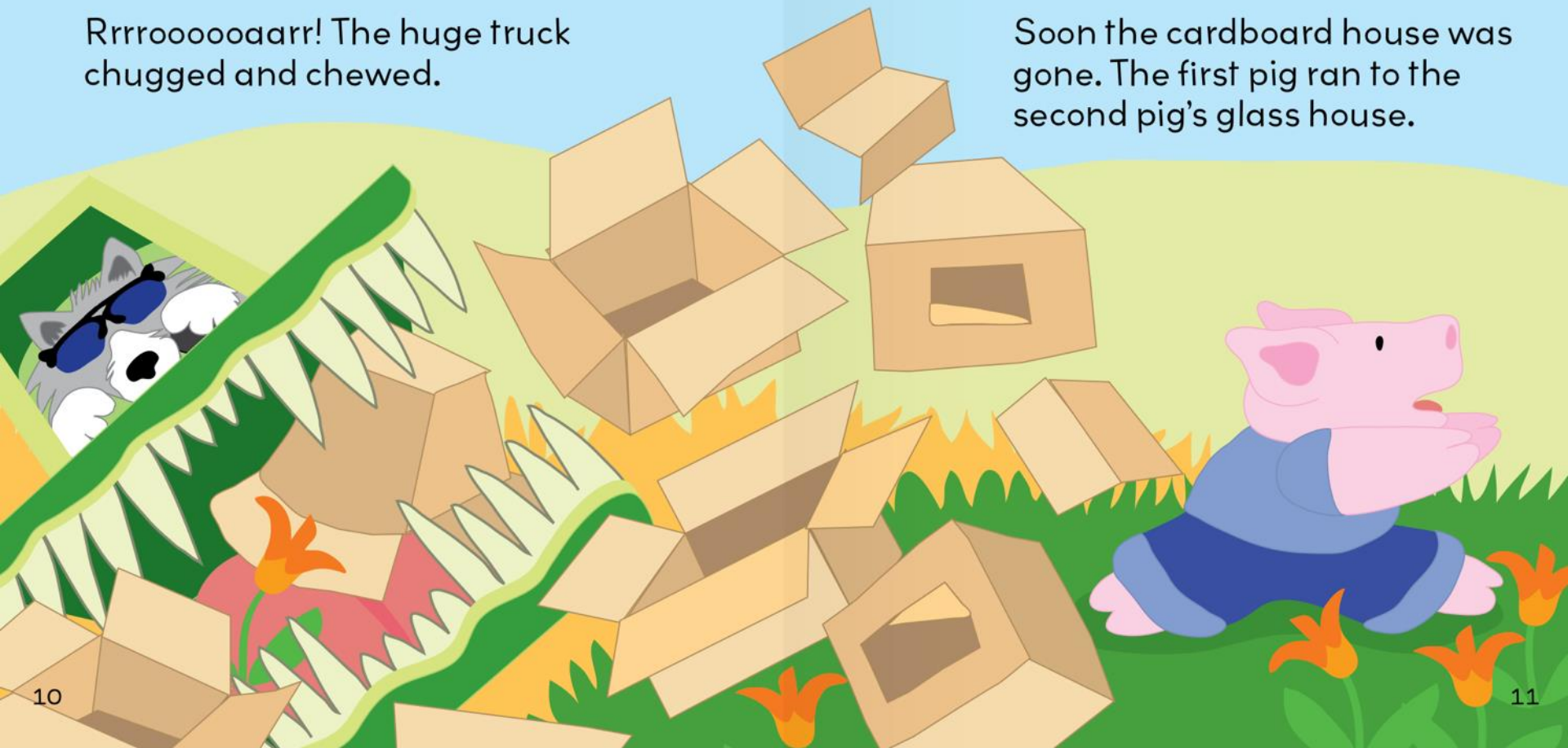


On trash day, A. Wolf came by in his giant trash truck. "I've come to take the trash!" he cried.


Rrrroooooaarr! The huge truck

“Whew,” said all three pigs.

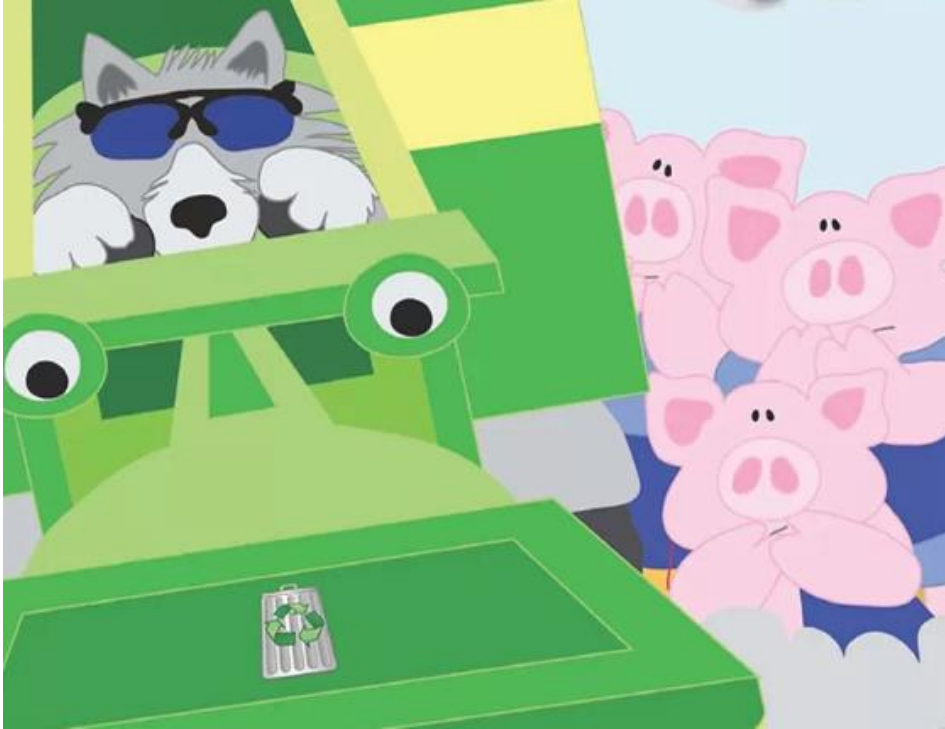
