Entrance Scholarships*

They are a one-time, merit-based scholarship awarded to qualifying international students when they receive an offer of admission from Trent University for an undergraduate program. The value of the scholarship ranges from \$1,000 to \$3,000.

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS

The following minimum admission requirements do not guarantee entry to competitive programs.

International Baccalaureate (IB)

Minimum overall score of 26 (including bonus points) in IB diploma.

English Language A (not English Language B) with a minimum grade of 5 satisfies English requirement.

Prerequisite courses can be presented at Standard and/or Higher Level (for programs with a Mathematics prerequisite, Mathematics SL or HL is required. Math Studies is not acceptable).

HL courses completed with a grade of 5 and higher qualify for transfer credits.

British-patterned Education

Minimum ‘C’ grade in five O-level (IGCSE) subjects and two A-level (A2) subjects. Two AS subjects may be substituted for one A2 subject.

A grade of C in O-level English satisfies English requirement.

A2 courses completed with a grade of C or higher qualify for transfer credits.

American-patterned Education

Minimum ‘B’ average (3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale) in a recognized academic grade 12 program with at least four different senior level academic subjects.

A minimum grade of 70% in English 12 satisfies English requirement.

AP courses with grade of 4 or higher qualify for transfer credits.

Ontario Secondary School Diploma

Minimum 70% average in best six 4U/M courses.

Each applicant is reviewed on an individual basis for meeting English requirement.

China High School Diploma

Minimum 75% average.

India Senior School Certificate

70% average in Standard XII on CBSE or state board exams. (Academic subjects only)

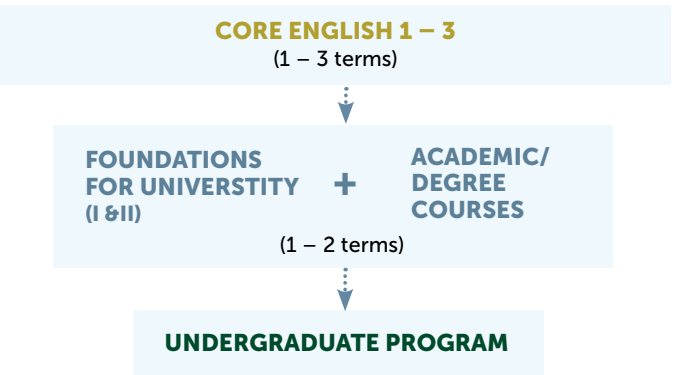

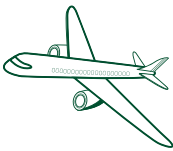

University Health Insurance Plan

When you come to study or work at an Ontario university, you must have insurance to pay the cost of health care services and medical treatments. The University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) is a mandatory health plan for all international non-residents studying or working at a participating university or affiliated college in Ontario.

UHIP applies to: international students studying in Ontario international employees working in Ontario who cannot get OHIP family members of international students and employees who are not eligible for OHIP Canadian employees or other individuals who are satisfying the OHIP waiting period short-term visitors associated with a participating university.

UHIP provides coverage for basic medical services and treatments you and your eligible dependents might need to maintain your health while living in Canada.
