## Instructional Strategies

Slide 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Welcome the students to the unit.</li> <li>Ask the students how their week has been and discuss some of the fun things they did at school or for fun to establish a rapport with your students.</li> <li>Ask the students if they have been to the Zoo before? What animals did they see? What animals can they see in this picture.</li> </ul>
Slide 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As a group, describe this picture of the fox.</li> <li>Discuss the picture brainstorming what might be happening in the picture and what might happen next?</li> </ul>
Slide 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discuss the learning goals with your students.</li> </ul>
Slide 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Simple past tense definition.</li> <li>Talk through the examples with the students. Ask them to give you examples about what they did during the day.</li> <li>Write down some examples of past tense.</li> </ul>
Slide 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Examples of past tense</li> </ul>
Slide 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have students take turns joining the present and past tense words by drawing a line between them.</li> </ul>
Slide 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have students take turns giving you the past tense word and then creating the past tense sentence.</li> <li>You can write or type in what they say on the slide.</li> </ul>
Slide 9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask the students to think about the activities or tasks that they did yesterday.</li> <li>Have a conversation or one-sided monologue about the activities that the students did yesterday.</li> <li>Give the students a few moments to think and ask them to focus on using past tense.</li> <li>For students who are finding it difficult, use prompting questions to begin the thought process.</li> </ul>
Slide 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prior to reading the story, ask students to think about the picture of the front cover. From previous learning ask students to identify the title, author and illustration.</li> <li>Ask students to think about the illustration. What can they see? What animals is it and how do they know? Why is the fox hiding? Why is it the sox fox?</li> <li>Have a conversation about the two spelling's of the plural of socks/sox.</li> <li>Teachers student be encouraged to discuss some of the vocabulary which may not b familiar to the students. (This is based on your understanding of the student/s).</li> <li>During the reading, the teacher should continue the visually scaffolding of vocabulary to ensure that students are understanding the story.</li> <li>Read through the story The Sox Fox.</li> <li>Point out the adjectives and rhyming words.</li> </ul>
Slide 26	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask the students to think about all of the 'ks' and 'x' sounds they have previously come across</li> <li>Think about words such as 'box or fox' and 'cooks or looks.'</li> <li>Create a list of words.</li> <li>If the students are having difficulty spelling the words, help them sound the words out.</li> </ul>
Slide 27/28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Say the word</li> <li>Find the picture and connect the words</li> </ul>
