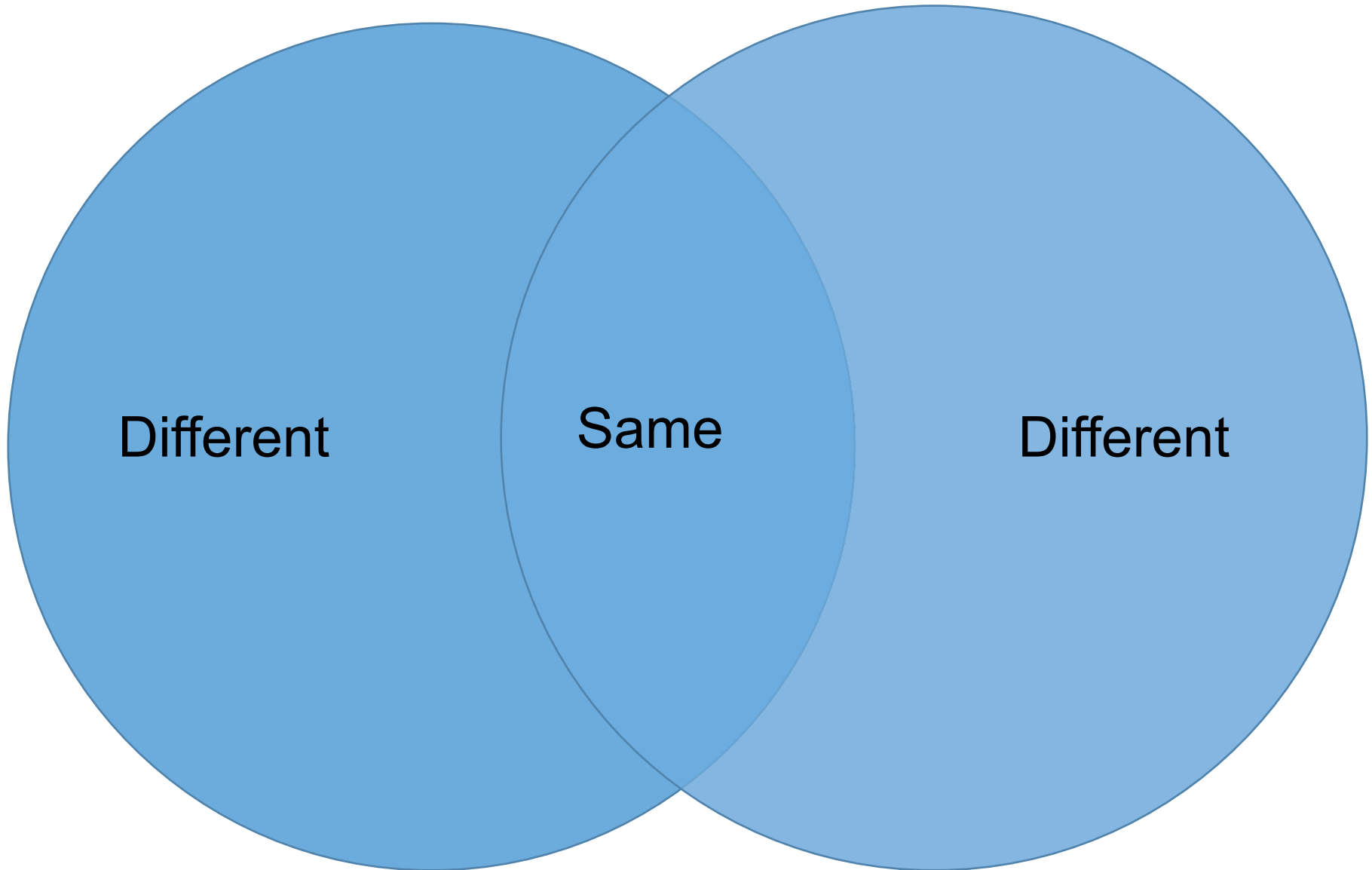

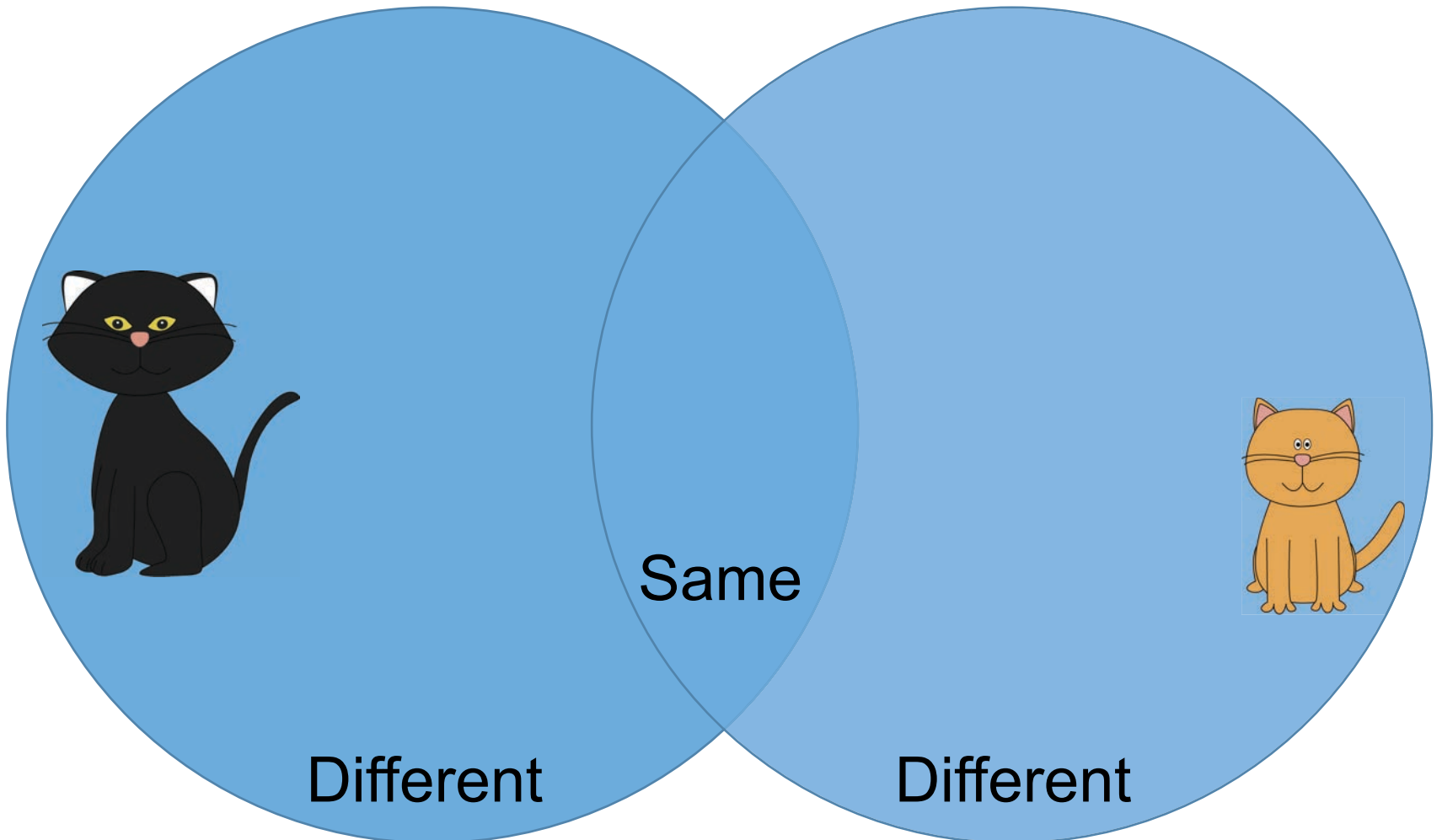


Venn Diagram

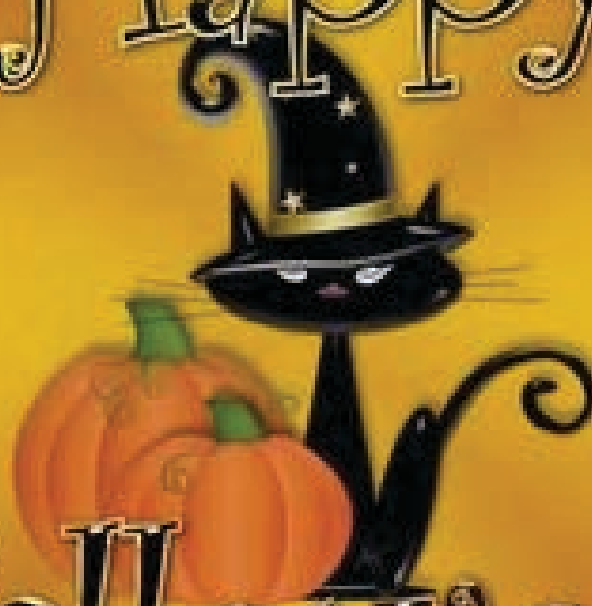


Venn Diagram Example
