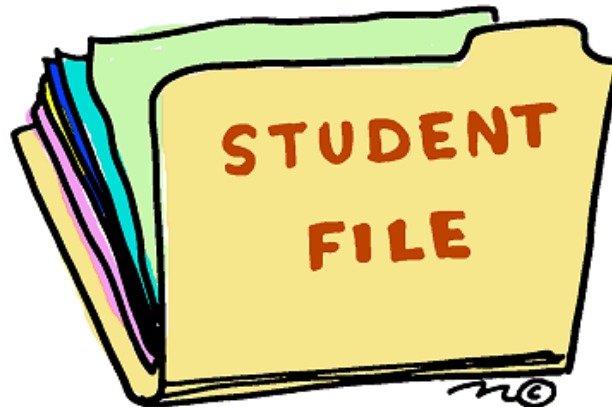

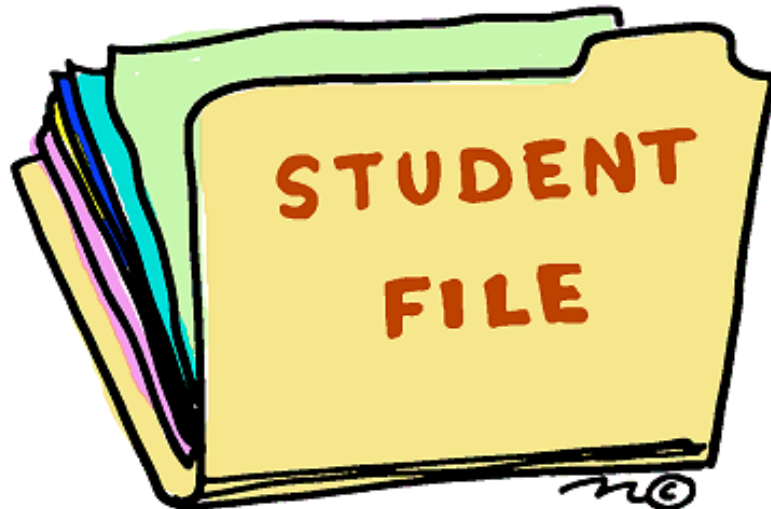

When we compare two things

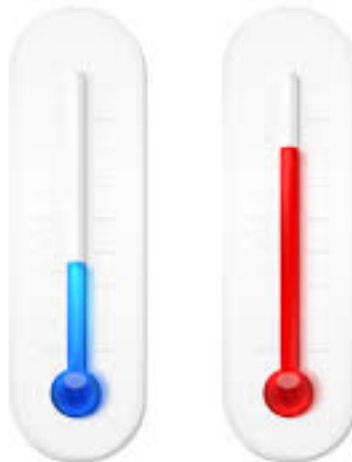
Ex: The black cat is **bigger** than the orange cat
