Example: My birthday is **June 26th 1997**

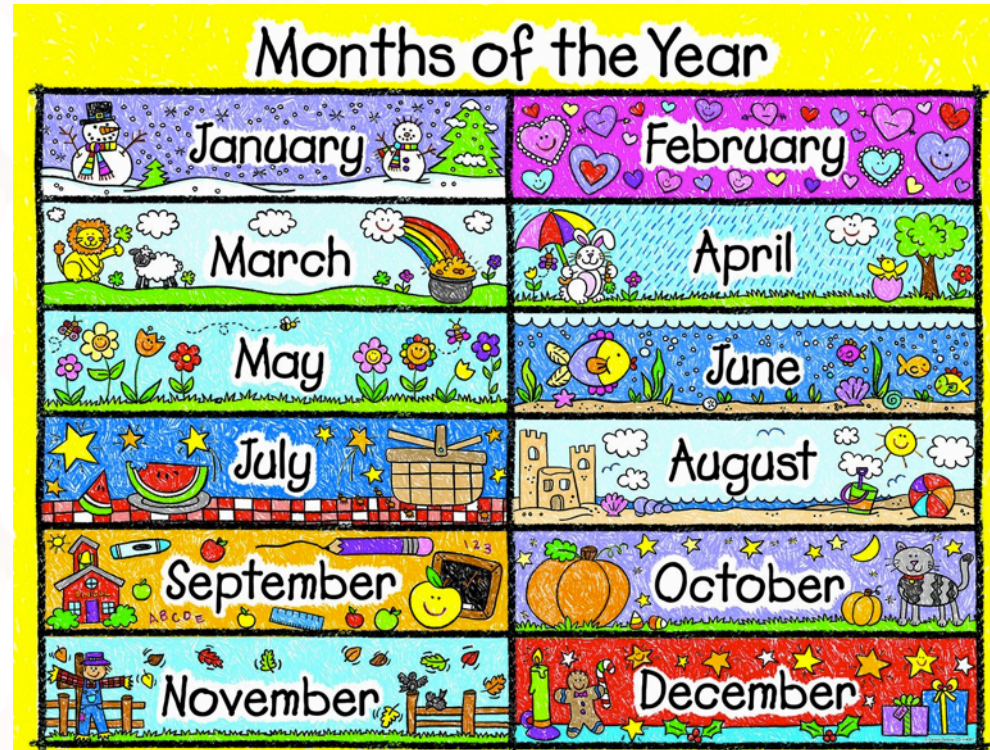

"Spring"

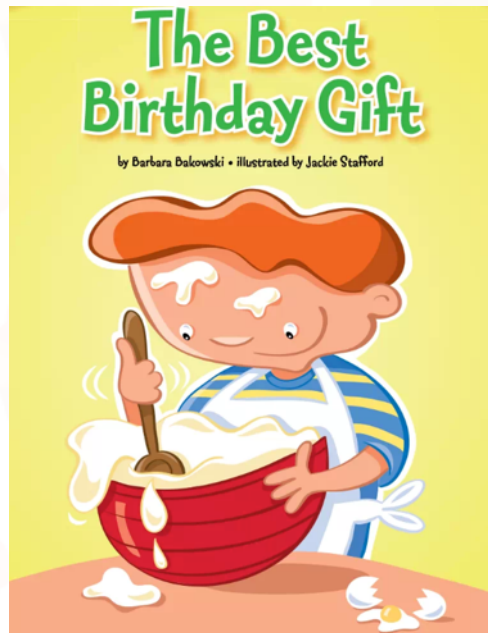
(to the tune of "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star")
