

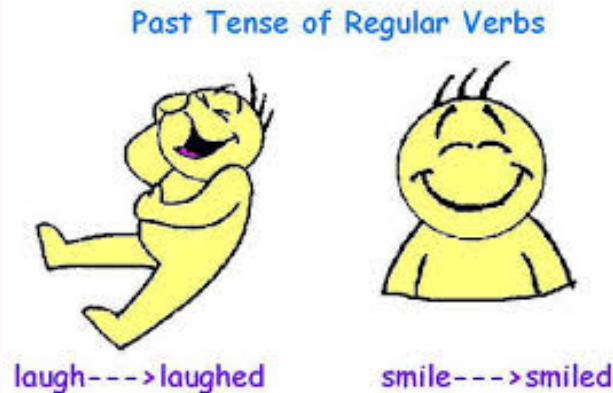

What is Valentine's Day?

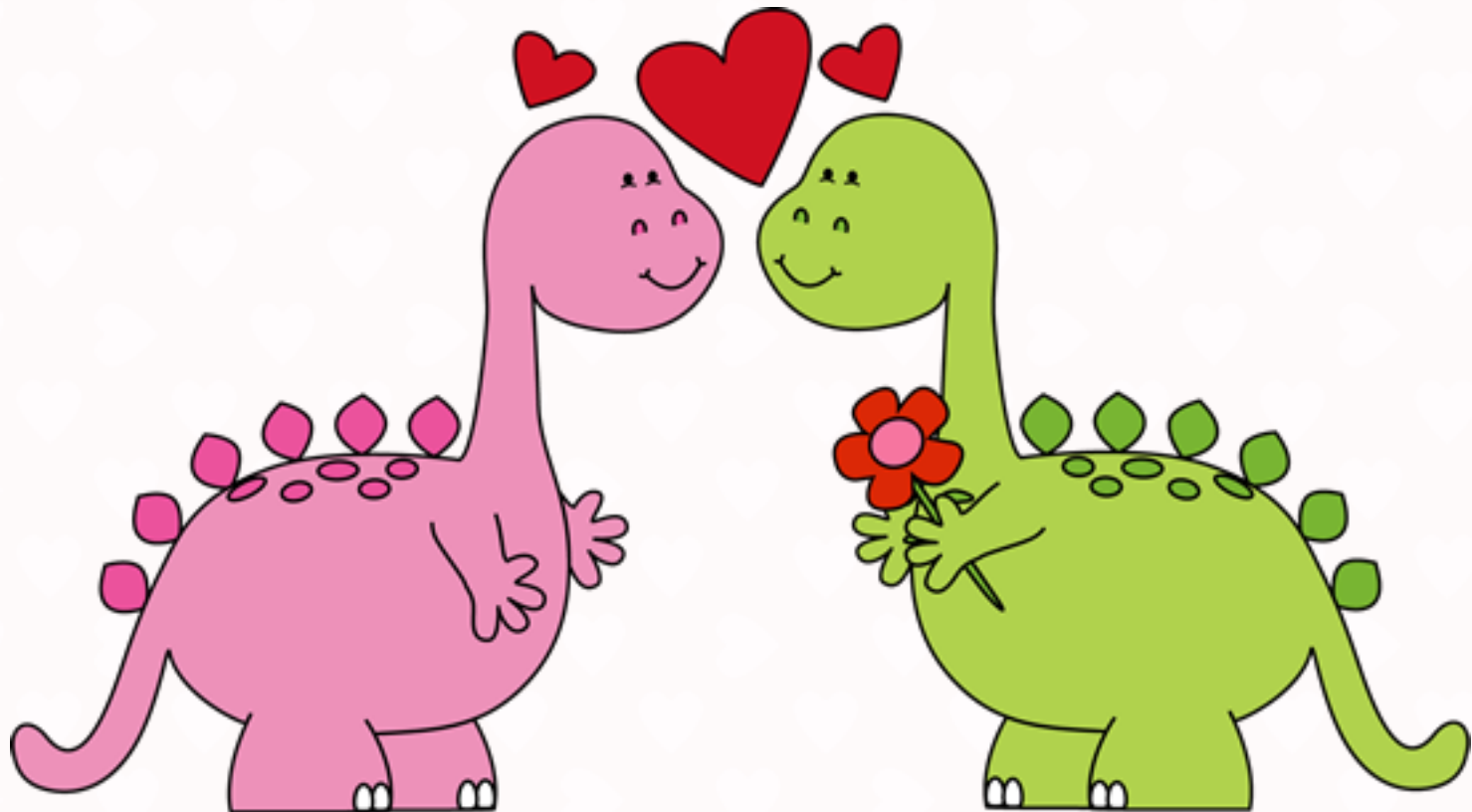
Valentine's Day is celebrated on February 14th.

On Valentine's Day we do nice things for the people we love!

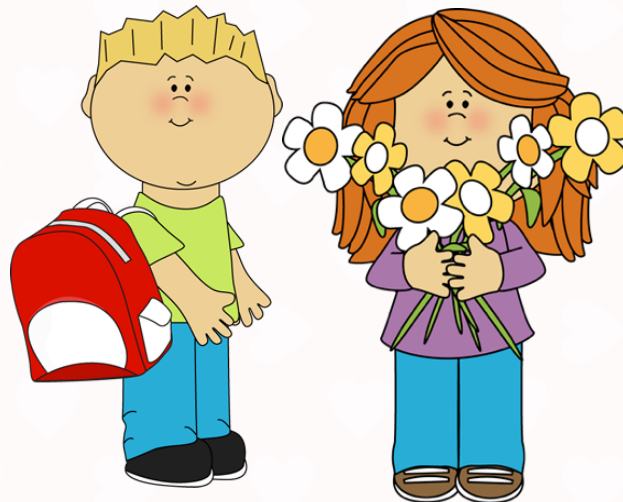


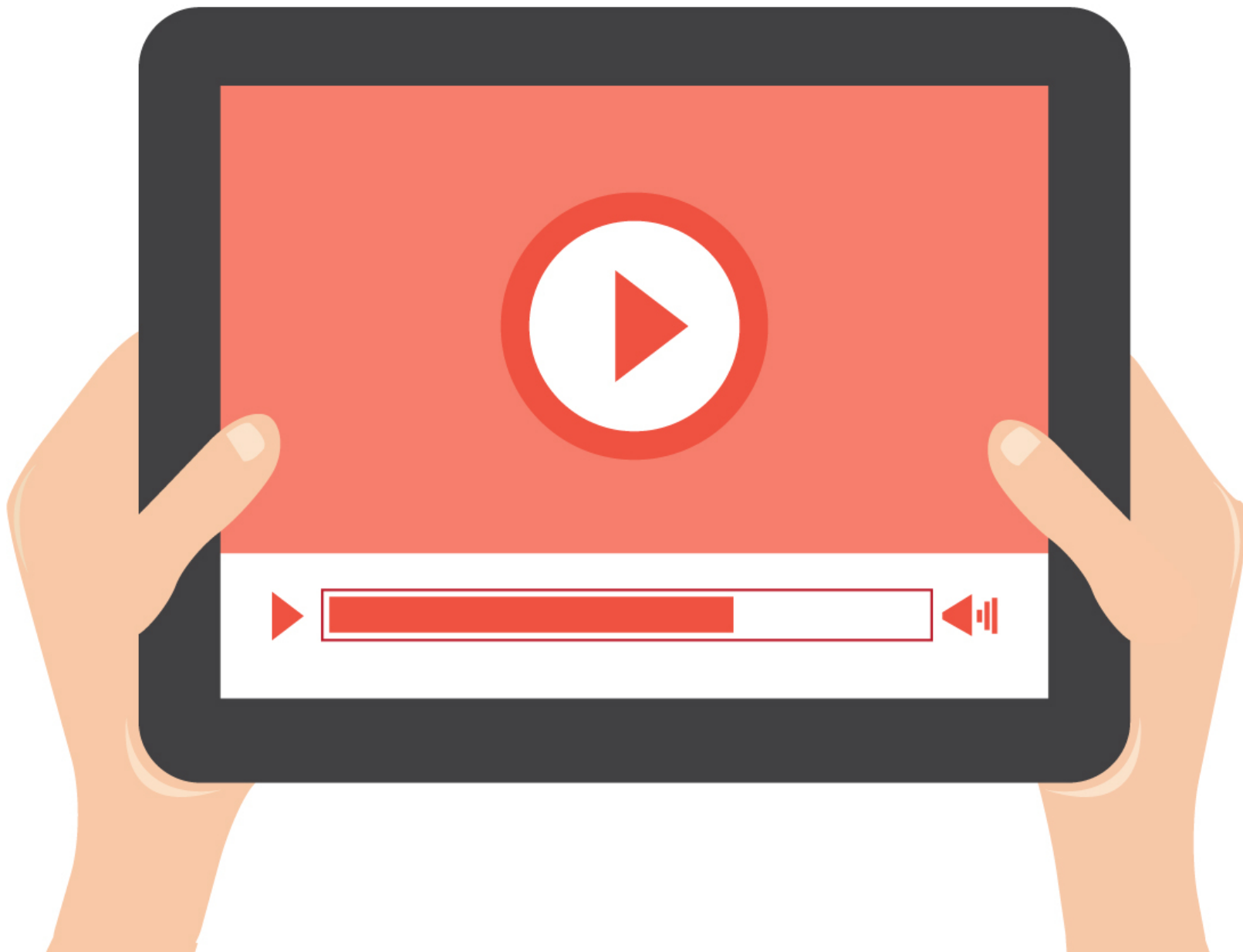
The Story of Cupid
