Jess likes pumpkin pie.



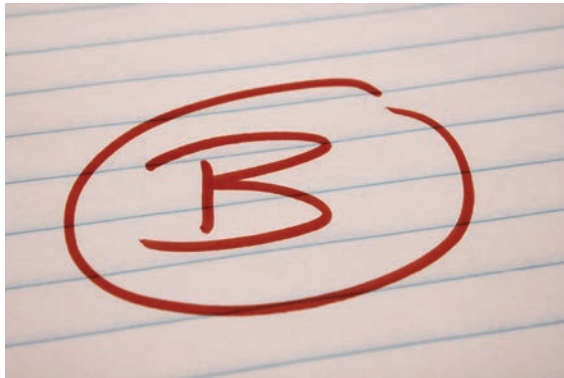

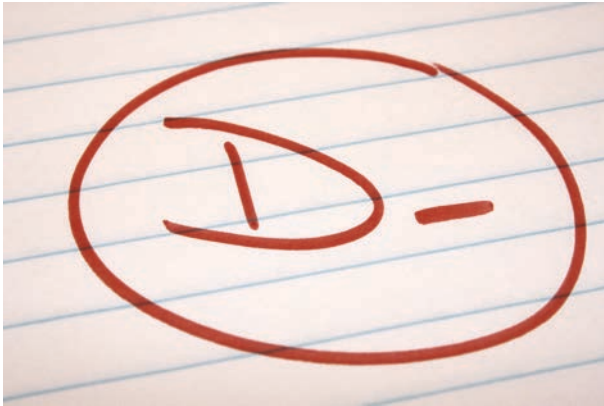

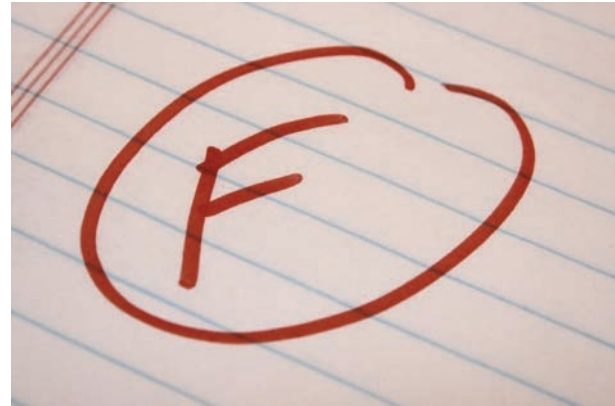
