


What is Alliteration?

Alliteration is words in a row in a sentence or poem that begin with the same letter. Example: Ally the ant ate apples.






Animals that begin with the letter 'M'




Alligator

Alex the Alligator Always Ate Apples










As you watch the video for the second time write down 'h' words you hear!


Ha ha, ho ho, hee hee hee—sing this happy song with me.

Half a herd of happy hippos hung out in a huddle.






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Tongue Twister!
