





Be sure to include everyone so that everyone can HAVE FUN!











Adding 'ing' to a word

When we add 'ing' to a verb we change it into a noun!

• Example: I like to **swim**. In the summer I like **swimming**.





Adding 'ing' to a word

Add 'ing' to the verb

Verb	'ing'
Fall	
Sit	
Eat	



Removing the 'e'

- Sometimes we have to remove the 'e' and the end of the word <u>before</u> we add 'ing'
- Example: I like to **skate**. In the winter I like **skating**.





Adding 'ing' to a word

Remove the 'e' and add 'ing' to the verb

Verb	'ing'
Hike	
Skate	
Dance



Alliteration Review!


Alliteration is words in a sentence or poem that begin with the same letter.

Animals that begin with the letter 'M'




Tongue Twisters

The big black bug bit the big black bear, But the big black bear bit the big black bear bit










