

### Noun Review

#### A noun is a person, place or thing!



## Noun Modifiers

## We often use **two nouns together** to show that **one thing is a part of something else**

Examples: The car door The house window The chair leg







## Noun Modifiers

## We can use noun modifiers to show what something is **made out of**

Examples: The gold watch The leather purse The wool sweater







## Noun Modifiers

## We often use noun modifiers with nouns ending in -er and -ing

Examples: An office worker A shopping list A swimming lesson
