
First Find a piece of paper!




Next .. Fold the paper in half!




Step 2: Fold the paper again ->



Step 2: Fold the two sides of the paper in towards the middle. Then turn over your folded paper.




Step 3: Draw a nose and eyes!

Noun Review

A noun is a person, place or thing!



We often use **two nouns together** to show that **one thing is a part of something else**

Examples: The car door The house window The chair leg







We can use noun modifiers to show what something is **made out of**

Examples: The gold watch The leather purse The wool sweater







We often use noun modifiers with nouns ending in –er and -ing

Examples: An office worker A shopping list A swimming lesson







We put two nouns together and **readers or listeners have to work out** what we mean

Examples: An ice bucket = a bucket to keep ice in


Examples: An ice cube = a cube made out of ice




