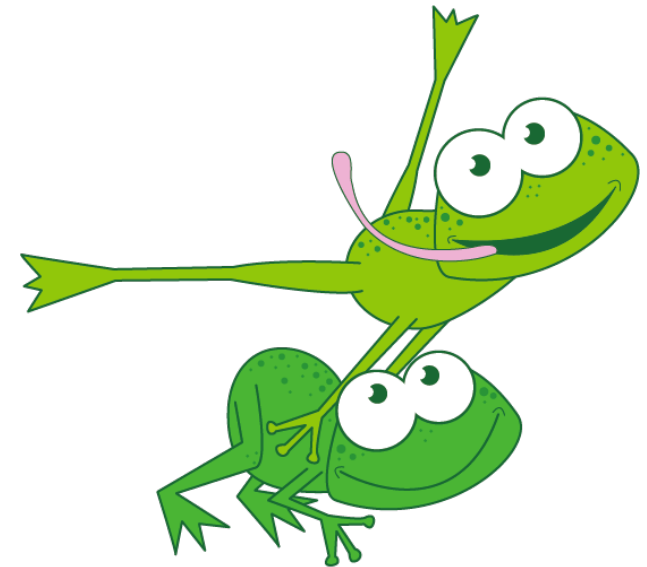


I had a little puppy
