I like to water our garden and cut the vegetables for dinner.



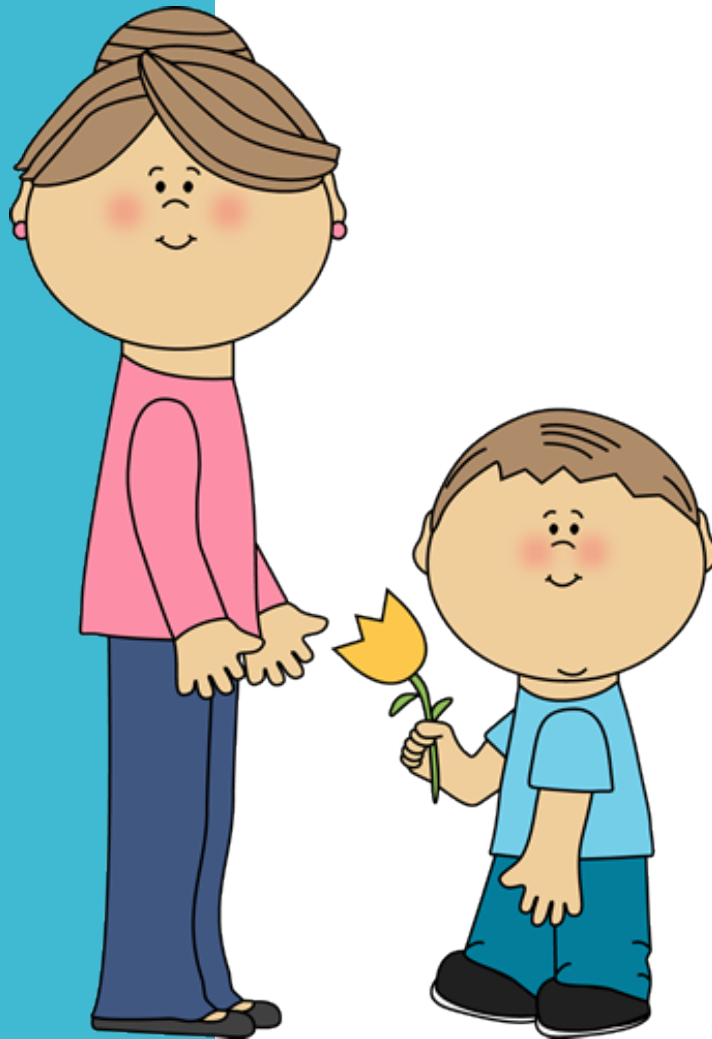
