Make a Puzzle


There are so many parts to a community, but somehow they all fit together, kind of like the pieces of a jigsaw puzzle. Follow these steps to make a puzzle picture of your community!

You'll need: crayons, markers or colour pencils, a blank piece of paper, cardboard, glue and scissors.



Step 1: On the paper, draw a colourful picture of your neighbourhood or community!


Step 2: Draw a puzzle that looks something like this on the cardboard. Your pieces do not all have to be the same size but they should be easy for you to cut out.



Step 3: Glue the picture of your community onto the blank side of the cardboard. Let the glue dry.



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Step 4: Carefully cut along the lines of the puzzle pieces (you might need to ask an adult to help you with the cutting)

Step 5: Mix up all your puzzle pieces and see if you can put them back together!
