Instructional Strategies

Slide 1 | Introduction slide, You can introduce the topic and ask students if they have any

	predictions about what they think the unit will be about. Go through the learning goals with students and ensure that they know the vocabulary words presented? This would be a good time to review previous lessons.
Slide 2-3	"WH" questions. When are they used? (reporting, story writing, paragraphs, essays)
Slide 3-4	Brainstorm a journal page and together write a journal entry of your lesson time together. What pictures and "stand out" moments should be included?
Slide 5	Can each student fill out a different word family house and then share?
Slide 6-7	Students can decide if they are going to interview someone else and complete the "all about me" page about them OR they can complete a journal entry that looks at travel or even weather.
Slide 8-12	Review all the parts of a story discussed last class. Go through a joint example with the class.
Slide 13-14	Students should complete either the book review for their own personal story or a story that they have read OR a comic strip that tells a story (beginning, middle and end)
Slide 15-22	Read "small" and discuss descriptive words
Slide 23	Review topics covered and time for any questions that students have had throughout the unit.
