




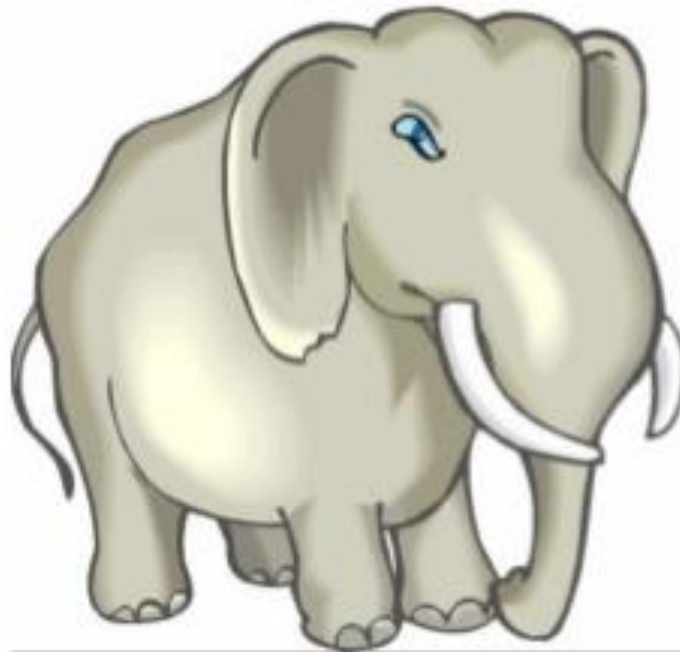


HOW TO MAKE COPARATIVE ADJECTIVES
