## Instructional Strategies

Slide 1	Introduction slide, You can introduce the topic and ask students if they have any predictions about what they think the unit will be about
Slide 2	Go through the learning goals with students and ensure that they know the vocabulary words presented? This would be a good time to review previous

	lessons.
Slide 3	Weather idioms-what do these have to do with the weather?
Slide 4-8	"WH" questions. Reporters always ask these questions. They are also questions that we answer when we are creating a journal entry and ensuring that we have enough detail when we are doing a retell. Explore each question and have them report on one another answer the questions.
Slide 9-10	Doing your own reporting. They can use the slides as "field notes" and have them answer questions.
Slide 11-18	Going through the stages of journaling and writing in general. Some of these concepts will be revisited next time when we talk about writing short stories. You can discuss how the writing process is the same (doesn't really matter what you are writing about)
Slide 19-20	Use the templates to have them do a "scrapbook style" journal. They can use pictures and words to tell the story of a vacation or fun time that they have had. "Singapore" page is the sample. They are to present their page when they are done. Be sure they include headings and pictures to "tell their story"
Slide 21	Travelling phrases and idioms. Review daily concepts.
