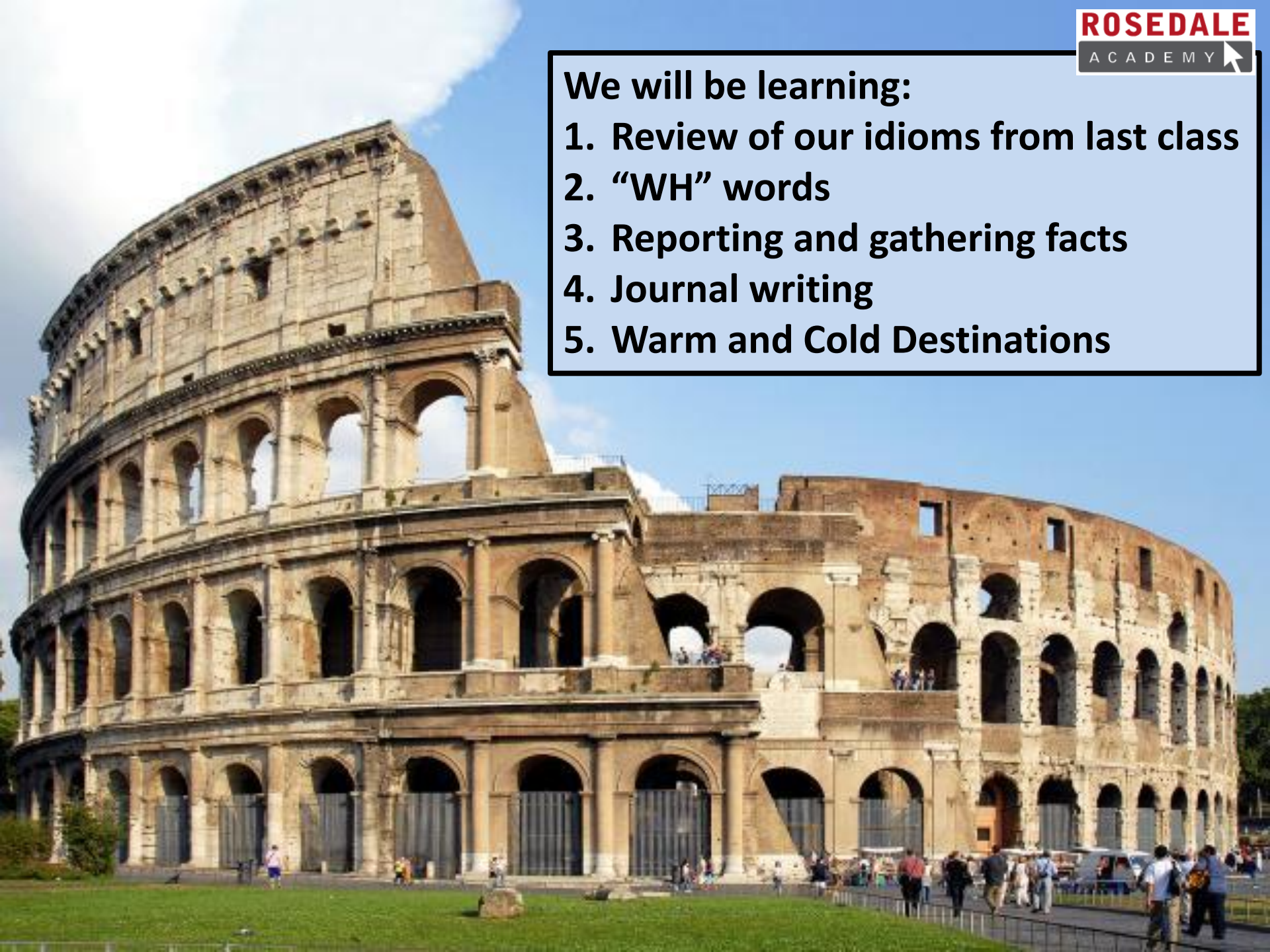

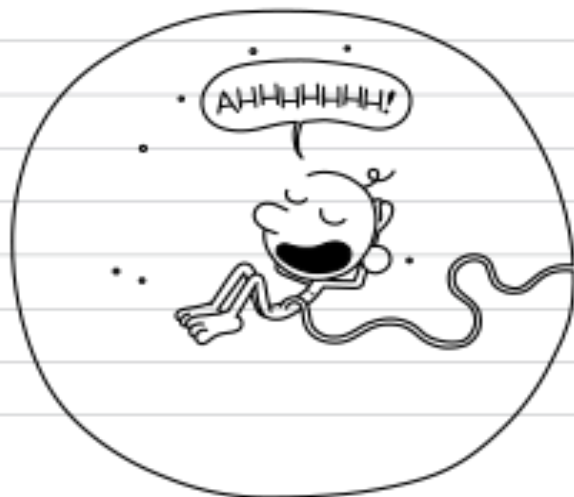
JANUARY
