Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a fulltime Rosedale Global High School OSSD student who has been enrolled in any Rosedale partner school for at least one academic year.

Criteria

Any student who has consistently demonstrated one or all the following attributes:

- High academic performance with high grade average
- Strong work ethic regularly demonstrated through effort, accountability, and determination
- Positive and supportive role model regularly demonstrating leadership, compassion, and generosity towards her/his peers and community

How to apply

Each Rosedale partner school may nominate one student for this award. Nominations must come directly from the school administrator and include:

- A brief recommendation letter explaining why the nominated student deserves this award
- Materials to support and demonstrate nominee's achievement(s)

Scholarship Amount

A scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 CAD will be awarded to one student.

The Scholarship Selection Committee, comprised of educators and Rosedale administrators, will select the award recipient after reviewing and ranking each applicant according to the scholarship criteria and merits of the recommendation letter.
