

## Rosedale Campus Manager v 1.2

**All Campuses page:** Shows course timelines from all campuses. Note that the “Sort by” dropdown menu (see red arrows) sorts information by Campus, Department, Course and Teacher. The other dropdown menus allow for more granular filtering of courses.

COURSES are predefined, which means they are the same for all campuses (example: ENG3U, MAT4M). CLASSES are just local iterations of courses, which means that they have a start and end date. Campus 1 and Campus 2 could both run the ENG3U course, but their classes would have different start/end dates. From what I can tell by the Milestones interface, we may be able to use it to represent courses if we could replace the “assigned to” field with 3 pre-defined roles, as shown here:

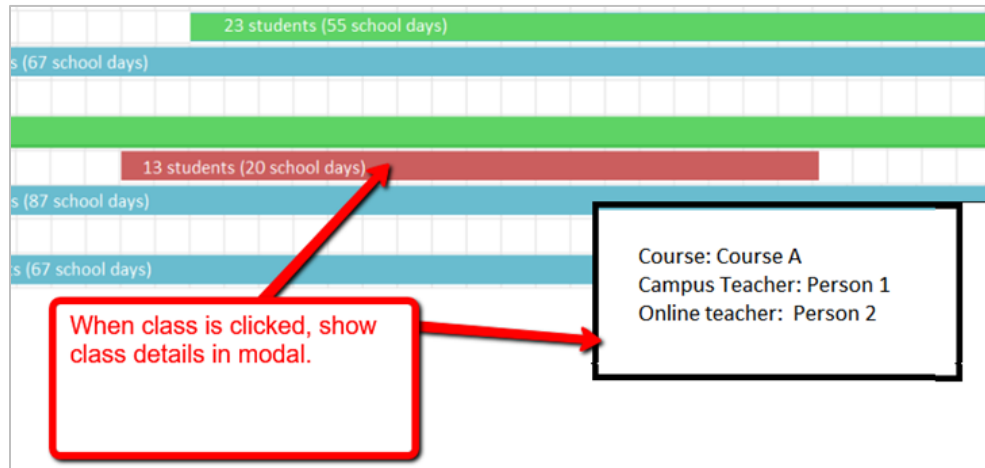

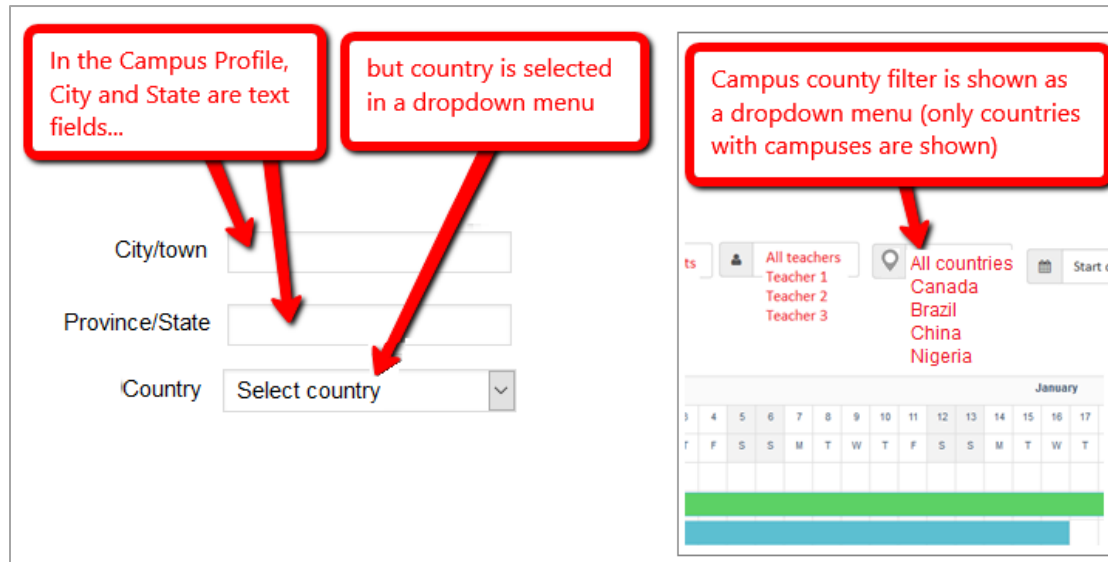

2. Campus profiles use country dropdown to set location. In Timeline view, campuses can be filtered by country.
